Synopsis: (from Third Party Films productions) “*Clinica de Migrantes* is a medical drama about a year in the life of Puentes, one of the only health clinics in the US involved in the politically controversial practice of providing health care to undocumented migrants. By law, illegal immigrants cannot obtain health insurance, and receive no regular medical treatment. At Puentes, a team of volunteers attend to an ever-growing population of housekeepers, prep cooks, and construction workers. Many come to Puentes after being turned away at other hospitals. Full of unforgettable patient-doctor interactions and human portraits, *Clinica de Migrantes* tells the story of America’s true untouchable class and of the heroic few who reach out to help them.”

About the director: Maxim Pozdorovkin is the award-winning director of “Pussy Riot, A Punk Prayer.” His new documentary, *Clinica de Migrantes*, has also won numerous awards, including the Jury Award at the Full Frame Festival in Durham in 2016.
