The HHIVE Undergraduate Research Assistant (URA) program requires a 5-hour a week commitment that includes attending bi-weekly lab meetings, working on HHIVE-related tasks in the lab, and regularly checking in with the HHIVE URA coordinator. HHIVE URA projects are primarily self-directed, so prospective URAs should be self-starters who can work independently and in a group.

Current HHIVE needs include marketing and promotion of HHIVE people, events, and projects; writing content for the HHIVE blog (covering events and/or analysis of an issue); researching funding, publication, and presentation opportunities; conducting literature reviews on topics related to HHIVE projects; and supporting faculty and graduate student research projects.
